

Sasquatch BrewAm

FAQ:

1) What is the BrewAm?

The BrewAm is a golf tournament where you can play a round of golf with a celebrity brewer, sort of like a ProAm but it's way cooler! While having fun with some of the best brewers in the nation, know that all proceeds benefit the Glen Hay Falconer Foundation.

2) What is the Glen Hay Falconer Foundation?

The Foundation was created to commemorate and celebrate the life, interests, and good works of a well-loved and leading Northwest brewer. The cornerstone of the Foundation is to contribute to the Northwest brewing community by providing educational opportunities for professional and aspiring brewers. The Foundation is offering two full-tuition scholarships with travel stipends to the Siebel Institute. 3) Where is the BrewAm?

The BrewAm is held at the Pub Course at McMenumins Edgefield in Troutdale, Oregon. Edgefield is 20 minutes from downtown Portland, five minutes from the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area, and 15 minutes from Portland International Airport.

4) How do I get there?

If you are driving, from downtown Portland, take I-84 east to Exit 16; follow 238th Drive south to the first traffic light; turn left at Halsey Street; and go east for one-quarter mile to McMenumins Edgefield. Edgefield is on your right. Check-in is outside the Distillery Bar.

5) When is the BrewAm? How long does it last?

The BrewAm is on Friday, July 24, 2009. Check-in begins at 8:00am outside the Distillery Bar. Please check in no later than 8:30am as the foursomes must head over to their assigned holes for a 9:00am prompt tee-off time. We anticipate that everyone will have completed the round of golf around noon. The cookout and award ceremony begin immediately thereafter. Everything should be wrapped up by 1:00pm giving us all plenty of time to freshen up and get over to the Oregon Brewers' Festival.

6) How do I sign-up? What is the cost? Is it tax-deductible?

It's easy! All you need to do is e-mail us at falconerfoundation@earthlink.net to make a reservation. Checks and money orders are the only form of payment that we are accepting this year. The Glen Hay Falconer Foundation has been granted nonprofit status under Section 501 (a) of the IRS code.

7) What information do I need to provide when I sign-up?

8) Can I stay at the Edgefield?

Of course, but the space is filling up quickly at the Edgefield. We have reserved a block of rooms on Thursday, July 23, 2009, the eve of the BrewAm. Call 503-669-8610 and ask for the "Sasquatch BrewAm" room block to reserve your room now. Come check out the course and the grounds and get the chance to run into a celebrity brewer at one of Edgefield's many unique bars.

9) Do I need my own clubs?

Edgefield has a limited number of rentals. We encourage you to bring your own clubs and balls. The Pub Course at Edgefield is a par-3, so you will only need a few clubs (pitching wedge & putter) and plenty of balls.

10) What is the format for the BrewAm?

The BrewAm is a shotgun start and scramble format. Look forward to lots of fun games and challenges along the course. We have great prizes and goodies for all!

11) What are you providing at the cookout?

To satisfy your hunger and quench your thirst, we will be providing a cookout of hamburgers and hot dogs and all the accompanying goodies along with beer. If you are vegetarian, please let us know so that we can have something to suit your taste.

12) What if it rains?

Rain or shine, the BrewAm is ON!

13) What if I need to cancel?

We anticipate the event being oversubscribed. So if we are able to fill your spot with someone from the waiting list, we will gladly offer you a refund.

14) Can I bring friends and family as spectators?

Of course, but the cookout is only for the participants.

15) What is a hole sponsor?
