

Sasquatch BrewAm

FAQ:

1) What is the BrewAm?

The BrewAm is a golf tournament where you can play a round of golf with a celebrity brewer, sort of like a ProAm but it's way cooler! While having fun with some of the best brewers in the nation, know that all proceeds benefit the Glen Hay Falconer Foundation's brewing scholarship program.

2) What is the Glen Hay Falconer Foundation?

The Foundation was created to commemorate and celebrate the life, interests, and good works of a well-loved and leading Northwest brewer. The cornerstone of the Foundation is to contribute to the Northwest brewing community by providing educational opportunities for professional and aspiring brewers. Each year, the Foundation currently offers three full-tuition scholarships with travel stipends to the Siebel Institute of Technology and the American Brewers Guild.

3) Where is the BrewAm?

The BrewAm is held at the Pub Course at McMenamins Edgefield in Troutdale, Oregon. Edgefield is 20 minutes from downtown Portland, five minutes from the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area, and 15 minutes from Portland International Airport.

4) How do I get there?

You can drive or catch the "Beer Bus" from Portland. We will provide more details a couple of weeks before the event, but we are planning on two Beer Bus pick-up spots, one at Rogue Ales in downtown and the other at the Horse Brass Pub on the other side of the river.

If you are driving from downtown Portland, take I-84 east to Exit 16; follow 238th Drive south to the first traffic light; turn left at Halsey Street; and go east for one-quarter mile to McMenamins Edgefield. Edgefield is on your right. Check-in is outside the Distillery Bar.

5) When is the BrewAm? How long does it last?

The BrewAm is on Friday, July 23, 2010. Check-in begins at 8:00am outside the Distillery Bar. Please check in no later than 8:30am, as the foursomes must head over to their assigned holes for a 9:00am prompt tee-off time. We anticipate that everyone will have completed the round of golf around noon. The picnic lunch, raffle and award ceremony begin immediately thereafter. Everything should be wrapped up around 1:00pm giving us all plenty of time to freshen up and get over to the Oregon Brewers' Festival.

6) How do I sign-up? What is the cost?

It's easy! From our website, simply follow the online sign-up instructions and pay by PayPal. You can also e-mail us at falconerfoundation@earthlink.net to make a reservation and pay by check or money order made payable to the "Glen Hay Falconer Foundation."

7) What information do I need to provide when I sign-up?

Please include your name and e-mail address in case we need to be in touch prior to the BrewAm.

8) Can I stay at the Edgefield?

Of course, but the space is filling up quickly at the Edgefield. We have reserved a block of rooms on Thursday, July 22, 2010, the eve of the BrewAm. Call 503-669-8610 and ask for the "Sasquatch BrewAm" room block to reserve your room now.

9) Do I need my own clubs?

Edgefield has a limited number of rentals. We encourage you to bring your own clubs and balls. The Pub Course at Edgefield is a par-3, so you will only need a few clubs (pitching wedge & putter) and plenty of balls.

10) What is the format for the BrewAm?

The BrewAm is a shotgun start and scramble format. Look forward to lots of fun games and challenges along the course. We have great prizes and goodies for all!

11) What are you providing at the picnic?

To satisfy your hunger and quench your thirst, we will be providing a picnic of pizza and salad along with more beer, of course. The picnic takes place in the Ballroom on the second floor of the main McMenamins Edgefield building.

12) What if it rains?

Rain or shine, the BrewAm is ON!

13) What if I need to cancel?

We anticipate the event being oversubscribed. So if we are able to fill your spot with someone from the waiting list, we will gladly offer you a refund.

14) Can I bring friends and family as spectators?

Of course, but the picnic is only for the participants.

15) What is a hole sponsor?
